HURRICANE CHECKLIST

Hurricane season began on June 1. It's never too late to start gathering supplies you may need if a storm occurs.

This list is not a complete inventory and intended as a basic checklist of suggested items:

- · Charge cell phones
- Charge portable cell chargers
- · Bags of ice
- Bottled water
- Batteries
- · Candles, lighters, and flashlights
- · Fill propone tank
- Cash
- TarpPet food
- Fill gas cans
- Trash bags
- Important contacts
- Insurance documents
- Canned food
- · Fill bathtub and buckets with water
- Charge batteries for tools, such as chainsows, leaf blowers, and screwdrivers

When in doubt about additional preparations, see what your neighbors are doing.
